The Evangelism Challenge – Invite 8

The Challenge

Invite 8 people to EBC on April 5, 2026. Pray Boldly. Watch God Move.

Rooted in the Great Commission

Before Jesus ascended into heaven, He gave His disciples a command — not a suggestion.

Matthew 28:19–20 (NIV)

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations... teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

The Resurrection was not the end of the story. It was the beginning of the mission.

Because Jesus rose, we go.

The Resurrection Sunday Challenge is our intentional response to the Great Commission. We are called to:

- Go beyond our comfort zones
- Share the good news
- Invite others into fellowship
- Trust God for transformation

We are not simply inviting people to attend a service. We are participating in Christ's command to make disciples.

The Foundation Scripture

Psalm 5:12 (NIV)

“Surely, Lord, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.”

We believe God gives divine favor as we step out in faith and obedience.

How to Invite Someone to Church

A Simple Evangelism Framework

1 Pray for Divine Favor and Open Doors

Before you speak, pray.

Ask God to:

- Prepare hearts.
- Create natural conversations.
- Give you courage and clarity.
- Surround you with divine favor (Psalm 5:12).

Evangelism begins in prayer, not pressure.

2 Build Relationship Before Invitation

People respond to connection.

- Listen.
- Care.
- Ask questions.
- Be present.

An invitation flows naturally from relationship.

3 Share What God Has Done for You

You don't need a sermon. Share your story.

- How has God blessed you?
- What has prayer changed in your life?
- How has your church family encouraged you?

Your testimony is powerful.

4 Share Scripture That Fits Their Need

As conversations unfold, gently share God's Word.

Examples:

- For worry: Philippians 4:6–7
- For hope: 1 Peter 1:3
- For strength: Isaiah 40:31
- For peace: John 14:27

Let Scripture speak.

5 Extend Simple, Consistent Invitations

Keep it natural.

Examples:

- "Would you join me at church this Easter?"
- "My church is celebrating Resurrection Sunday on April 5. I'd love for you to join me."

- “We have two services at 8 and 10:15 a.m. — which one works for you?”

Be warm. Be clear. Be confident.

6 Maintain a Personal Invite List

Write down each person’s name. Pray daily.

Follow up:

- Send a reminder midweek (April 1).
- Offer to sit with them.
- Text them Saturday evening (April 4).

Consistency shows care.

Using Digital Platforms to Share the Invitation

Extending the Great Commission Online

The Great Commission doesn’t stop at church doors. It extends to digital spaces.

Social media is today’s marketplace, neighborhood, and gathering space. When you post, share, or send a message, you are planting seeds.

You don’t need to be tech-savvy. You just need to be intentional. Below are 25 social media prompts.

Resurrection & Easter Focus

1. Resurrection Sunday changed everything. Join me April 5 at Elevation Baptist Church.
2. The tomb is empty. Hope is alive. Easter at EBC — 8 or 10:15 a.m.
3. Easter isn’t about tradition. It’s about transformation.

19. Community matters. Faith grows here.
20. Worship isn't routine — it's revival.
